

Bingo Rules

- 1.** It is prohibited to consume any food or drink not purchased from SS&A. There may be exceptions to this rule under specific circumstances. Speak with SS&A Management for approval.
- 2.** All sales will cease at 10.40am to enable the Caller to get ready for eyes down at 10.45am.
- 3.** It is against Licensing Laws to have persons under the age of 18 attend Bingo.
- 4.** Reserving of seats is against SS&A policy – this includes leaving property e.g. dabbers in place on a table. All reserved seats not claimed by this time must be released for others. SS&A takes no responsibility for any loss or tampering of personal property.
- 5.** Redemption of Free Bingo Books must be done strictly for, or by the person the books are purchased for. There may be exceptions to this rule determined by Caller.
- 6.** No books are to be played from previous days or removed from the venue. Offenders will be excluded from playing Bingo. Books will be marked on the back with a coloured pen corresponding to the day and only these books will be accepted as winners.
- 7.** Patrons may only play up to one Bingo Tablet at a time.
- 8.** All tablets MUST be signed in on the available sign in sheet.
Bingo wins can be voided if you are operating a tablet that is NOT assigned to you.
- 9.** All winners must physically be in the room to accept their prize.
If a winner is not in the room to claim their prize, the win may be voided.
Exceptions to this rule may be made at the Caller's discretion.
- 10.** Mobiles phones are to be switched off or turned to silent once calls commence at 10.30am.
- 11.** Winners are to call loud enough for the caller to hear and must be on the last number called.
It is the winners' responsibility to stop the caller in time.
- 12.** The Caller's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13.** The Caller has the discretion to make exceptions to the rules (with Management authority).
- 14.** Staff reserves the right to allocate disabled seating.
- 15.** Any member who displays unbecoming conduct as outlined in our Bylaws will be made to front the Board.
