Terms and Conditions:

Introduction

1. The SS&A Club's 80th Birthday Car Promotion will commence from 7pm Friday 4th September 2026 and run until Saturday 31st October 2026 at 8pm and will consist of 10 Minor Draw Dates and 1 Major Draw Date as set out in these terms with a combined total RRP prize pool of \$67,808 comprised of 1 x Renault Symbioz worth \$53,308 and \$14,500 cash.

This total prize pool will be distributed into the following;

- (a) Minor Draws: \$10000 cash divided into 10 separate draw sets of 10 x \$100 cash.
- (b) Major Draw – October 31st
 - (i) First prize – Renault Symbioz valued at \$53,308 RRP.
 - (ii) \$500 cash each for the other nine (9) finalists, totalling \$4,500.

2. The promoter of the Promotion is the SS&A Club.
3. Entry into the Promotion is subject to acceptance of these terms and conditions.
4. If there is any inconsistency between terms and conditions and anything else that refers to this Promotion, these terms and conditions will prevail.

Where to Enter & Collect Prizes

5. Each draw will be conducted by a Promotional Host at the SS&A Club located at 570-582 Olive Street Albury, using a promotional system and virtual barrel. Winners will be drawn by their Name and Membership number, and it will be announced over the public address system.
6. To participate in the Promotion, members must be physically and personally present at the SS&A Club (inside the building) on the Minor Draw nights to claim their prize. For the Major Draw night on Saturday 31st October, the finalists must be physically and personally present at SS&A Club (inside the building) by 7:30pm for the draw at 8pm.

Who can Enter?

7. To be eligible, entrants for the Promotion must be:
 - (a) Financial and current Members of the SS&A Club through the Promotional Period;
 - (b) Over the age of 18 years; and
 - (c) Agree to and comply with these terms and conditions.

Excluded Participants

8. You cannot participate in the Promotion if:
 - (a) You are suspended from membership of the SS&A Club at any time during the Promotional Period.
 - (b) You are a director, employee, or contracted personnel of the SS&A Club or you are the immediate family member of director, employee, and selected contracted personnel. (Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, de-facto spouse, child or stepchild, parent, step-parent, brother, sister and parent in laws.)
 - (c) You are not an Australian resident.
9. To successfully claim any prize, Members must provide proof of identity and proof of financial membership of the SS&A Club. Proof of identification and proof of membership considered suitable for verification is at the absolute discretion of the SS&A Club.

Prohibited prizes

Minor Draws

11. Minor Draws will take place on the following dates;

 - (g) 16th October 2026
 - (h) 23rd October 2026
 - (i) 30th October 2026
 - (j) 31st October 2026 (before Major Draw at 8pm)

How to Enter the Minor Draws?

12. Members can enter the Minor Draws by doing either/both of the following:
 - (a) Members will receive one free entry in the Virtual Barrel for swiping their Membership card at a kiosk and selecting the entry button. Members can claim this entry once per day, per Member. Only the person on the Membership card can swipe the Membership card for entries. If this is not adhered to, management reserves its right to exclude the member from the Promotion.
 - (b) Members will receive one entry in the Virtual Barrel for every \$10 accumulated spend at any Point of Sale throughout the SS&A Club. A \$10 spend will yield one entry, and a \$20 spend will yield two entries etc. Both EFTPOS and cash transactions are applicable. Purchases include food, beverages, raffle tickets, membership & takeaway liquor.
 - (c) Function tabs and all gaming related activities are not eligible for entry.
13. One Membership card can be swiped per transaction to earn entries into the Virtual Barrel. The Membership card must be swiped at the time of the transaction by the Member.
14. To avoid excessive redrawing on the draw day, entries must be activated between 5pm and 8pm on the draw day to be eligible to win in this Promotion. Entries can be activated via a kiosk button, or via any detected card activity at POS, EGM, or MTGM.
15. After every Minor Draw, previous entries and spend will be voided and zeroed and all new entries and spend will commence for the following Minor Draw.

What are the Minor Draw Prizes?

16. The Minor Draw prizes consist of 10 x \$100 in cash plus a finalist position in the Major Draw on Saturday 31st October 2026 at 8pm. The Minor Draws are drawn from the Virtual Barrel of members who received entries for the seven (7) days immediately preceding and including the Minor Draw date.

Major Draw Night – Saturday 31st October

20. On the Major Draw Night, Saturday 31st October 2026, the SS&A Club will conduct the last Minor Draw from the Virtual Barrel from 7pm. This will give a total of ten (10) finalists.
21. The Major Draw will occur at approximately 8:15pm.
22. Finalists in the Major Draw must be physically present at the SS&A Club and register with the Promotion host by 7.30pm on the Major Draw Night.
23. Finalists in the Major Draw must have their current membership card and a valid form of identification including a driver's license, passport, or NSW photo card with them to be eligible to win the Major Draw.
24. If one of the Major Draw finalists are not present by 7:30pm that member's name will be removed from the Virtual Barrel for the Major Draw and the Promotion host will draw an additional finalist at 8pm. This process will be repeated until ten (10) Major Draw finalists are present at the Major Draw.
25. If unforeseen circumstances including illness & death apply to one (1) of the Major Draw finalists, that finalist must notify the Club in writing prior to 7.30pm on the Major Draw Night

26. Once all ten (10) finalist positions are filled then the Major Draw will commence. This should commence from approximately 8:15pm.

 - (b) All boxes will be opened together. Nine boxes will contain \$500 cash, and one box will have the key to the vehicle.

Cancellation or postponement of a draw is strictly at SS&A Club managements discretion. In the event of a cancellation of a Minor Draw, an additional draw will take place the following week.
36. SS&A Club reserves the right to redraw any Minor Draw or the Major Draw if an entrant who claims to be a winner is unable to satisfy these Terms and Conditions.
37. The nine (9) Minor Draw winners who qualify as finalists for the Major Draw will be contacted by telephone during the week preceding the Major Draw scheduled for Saturday, 31 October 2026, as a courtesy reminder of the date, time, and location of the Major Draw. 38. If a Major Draw finalist does not answer the telephone call, the SS&A Club may leave a voicemail message (where that facility is available) using the contact details of the member as notified to the SS&A Club.

Copyright, Statutory Guarantees, Waiver and Liability

42. In consideration for the SS&A Club awarding the prize to the winners, and the winners accepting the prize, the winners hereby consent to the winner's submission, image and/or voice, as recorded, photographed or filmed during the winner's participation in the Minor Draw or Major Draw to appear in connection with the SS&A Club or the advertising or marketing thereof, and any media and the winner will not be entitled to any fee for such use.
43. SS&A Club does not exclude any rights and remedies in respect of goods or services under the Australian Consumer Law in the Competition and Consumer Act (2010) (Australian Consumer Law) that cannot be excluded, restricted, or modified. However, the remainder of this clause will apply to the fullest extent permitted by law and the SS&A Club shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with any prize/s except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.

49. Any deviation from these Terms and Conditions on the part of the SS&A Club acting reasonably shall not render the Promotion void so long as the SS&A Club is satisfied in its absolute discretion that the deviation does not result in any material unfairness in the conduct of the Promotion.

Dispute Resolution

50. For any dispute arising in relation to the Promotion, both parties agree to deal with such dispute in accordance with (a) to (f) of this clause sequentially:
 - (a) SS&A Customer Service Representatives will try to settle the dispute by direct negotiation with the member.
 - (b) If not resolved within five (5) days, the party claiming that there is a dispute under this Promotion will give the SS&A Club a Notice setting out the nature of the dispute and propose a solution. The date the dispute Notice is issued will be the Notice Date.
 - (c) Within ten (10) business days of the Notice Date, SS&A Club Management will nominate a representative (Representative) who has not had prior direct involvement in the dispute. Unless the proposed solution is acceptable to the Representative, the parties will meet within ten (10) business days of the Notice Date and try to settle the dispute by direct negotiation.
 - (d) Failing settlement within twenty (20) business days of the Notice Date, unless the parties agree to continue the mediation process for a further period agreed by the parties, the member will, without delay, refer the dispute to an appropriately qualified

mediator agreed by the Representative. If the parties are not able to agree on a mediator, the member will refer the dispute to the chairperson of an accredited mediation organisation to appoint a mediator, for mediation to commence within thirty (30) business days of the Notice Date or such other period as agreed by the parties.

- (e) For the mediation process, both parties agree to appoint nominees who are available to attend the mediation as a priority activity and have the authority to bind the relevant party. The nominees must act in good faith to genuinely attempt to resolve the dispute.
 - (f) If the dispute is not resolved within sixty (60) business days of the Notice Date, either the SS&A Club or the member may commence legal proceedings or, by agreement, continue the mediation process for a period agreed by the parties.
51. The costs of a mediator will be shared equally between the parties. The SS&A Club and the member will otherwise each bear their own costs associated with the dispute resolution.
52. Despite the existence of a dispute, the SS&A Club can continue this Promotion under these Terms & Conditions.
